- 5. Application must include title, size (including the frame), and medium of each work being submitted.
- 6. Submissions received after the deadline for entry will not be accepted.
- 7. Submission of works of art by the artist and acceptance by the jury is an agreement to show the submitted works for the duration of the exhibition.
- 8. All decisions of the jury are final.
- 9. Artists will be notified by e-mail of acceptance or rejection by July 22.
- Accepted artists will be required to deliver their works of art 10am 4pm, August 22 26 to the Orange County Regional History Center. All works of art must be "gallery ready" when delivered (i.e., all mounting hardware and wire must be included and attached).
- 11. Accepted artists will be required to pick up their works of art 10am 4pm, Oct 31 Nov 4 at the Orange County Regional History Center.
